Equipment is for privates unless otherwise noted.

Mandatory equipment:

- Brogans
- Wool Socks
- Issue Shirts (1 or 2)
- Mounted service shell jacket with red piping
- U.S. chevrons (NCO's only)
- Mounted trousers (striping for NCO's & piping for officers)
- Suspenders
- Kepi
- Artillery Cap Insignia
- Letter B and number 4 for cap
- 1st Division - 1st or 5th Corp patch
- Plain waist belt
- U.S. belt plate
- Pistol cartridge box
- Cap box
- Holster
- Wool blanket
- Period fork, knife & spoon
- U.S. tin plate
- Canteen
- Poncho
- 2 shelter tent halves (NCO's can have wedge tents)
- 6 tent stakes (need to make wooden poles for tents)

Optional Equipment: (for comfort and a better impression)

- Underdrawers (necessary if allergic to wool)
- Nipple pick (for pistol)
- 1860 Army Colt or 1858 Remington Revolver
- Pistol caps and black powder
- Muslin utensil bag
- Large cup
- 18th century wallet
- 18th century Hardy playing cards
- Period toothbrush
- Period comb
- Tent end (for shelter tents)
- Lantern
- Wax candles for lantern
